

Directions: In the space under Religion, state whether you believe the verse is from the Islamic holy book (Quran) with an “I” or the Christian holy book (Bible) with a “C”. Under the +/-, use the following scale to note how positive or negative you think the passage is: 1=extremely negative, 3=neither positive nor negative, 5=extremely positive.

1. And kill them wherever you overtake them and expel them from wherever they have expelled you, and temptation is worse than killing.		
2. Prepare slaughter for his iniquity of their fathers; that they do not rise, nor possess the land.		
3. Now therefore kill every male among the little one, and kill every woman that hath known man by lying with him.		
4. And if they cease, God is forgiving and merciful.		
5. If a damsel, a virgin be betrothed unto a husband, and a man find her in the city, and lie with her; then you shall bring them both unto the gate of that city, and you shall stone them with stones that they die.		
6. Your women are tilth unto you; so approach your tilth as you will.		
7. If a man meets a virgin who is not betrothed, and seizes were and lies with her, and they are found, then the man who lay with her shall give to the father of the young lady, fifty shekels of silver and she shall be his wife, because he has violated her.		
8. Tell thy wives and thy daughters and the women of the believers to draw their cloaks close round them.		
9. If a man lies with a male as with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination, they shall surely be put to death, their blood is upon them.		
10. Wives have the same rights as the husbands have on them in accordance with the generally known principles. Of course, men are a degree above them in status.		
11. Let the women Learn in silence, with all subjection.		
12. Depart from evil and do good, seek peace and pursue it.		
13. The share of the male shall be twice that of a female.		
14. If you fear highhandedness from your wives, remind them (of the teaching of God) and ignore them when you go to bed, and hit them.		

Note: The word “God” is used uniformly in both Islamic and Christian passages for both the Islamic deity (Allah) or the Christian deity (God or Jehovah).
