2. Evidence is provided that interviewee was made aware of purpose of interview and that confidentiality issues were addressed (i.e., informed consent attached). This must be provided when the assignment is turned in.	3		
3. Interviewee's social identity is compared and contrasted to author's and evidence that assigned questions were asked is provided. Does not simply summarize interview.	10		
4. Information gained from interview and consideration of own social identity is clearly and specifically linked to social identity theory and group privilege. Other theories are not used.	10		
5. Insights gained from experience are explained and are at least 1 page in length. Insights do not just summarize interview	7		
6. Formatting instructions/assignment criteria are followed. Word count is included on paper.	3
